My older sister's name is Felicitas. She's 21 years old and her education is a nurse-female helper. My youngest sister's name is Janine. She's 15 years old and a schoolgirl. At the moment I live with my family. I have three domestic animals, two dogs and one cat. The dogs' names are Tato and Catja. They are 6 and 10 years old.
